Transfer Your Photos

Windows XP lets you easily transfer the digital photos from your camera to your computer with just a few clicks of the mouse.

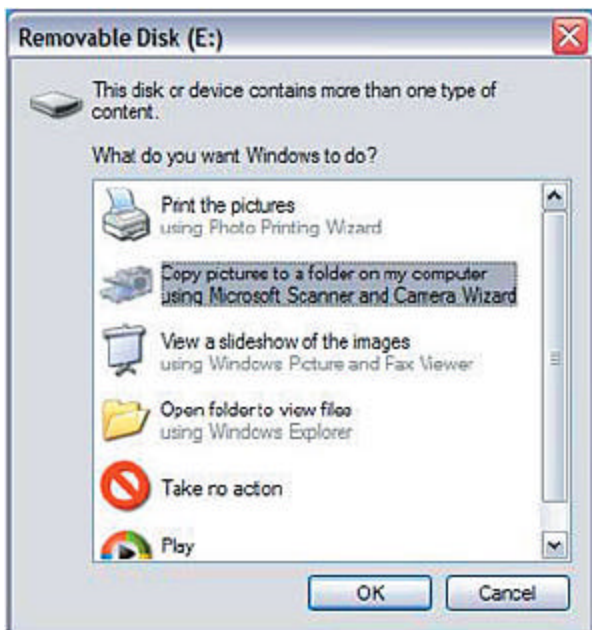
To get started, connect your digital camera to the computer with a Universal Serial Bus (USB) cable. Or connect your memory card and memory card reader (if required) to your computer, instead.

If your camera is Plug and Play, the Scanner and Camera Wizard starts as soon as you're connected. Click **Next** and follow the instructions in the wizard.

Note: If you do not see the Scanner and Camera Wizard, you may have an older camera that is not Plug and Play enabled. If that's the case, follow the instructions that came with your camera to connect it manually.

If the wizard asks which action you would like to perform, select **Always do the selected action**.

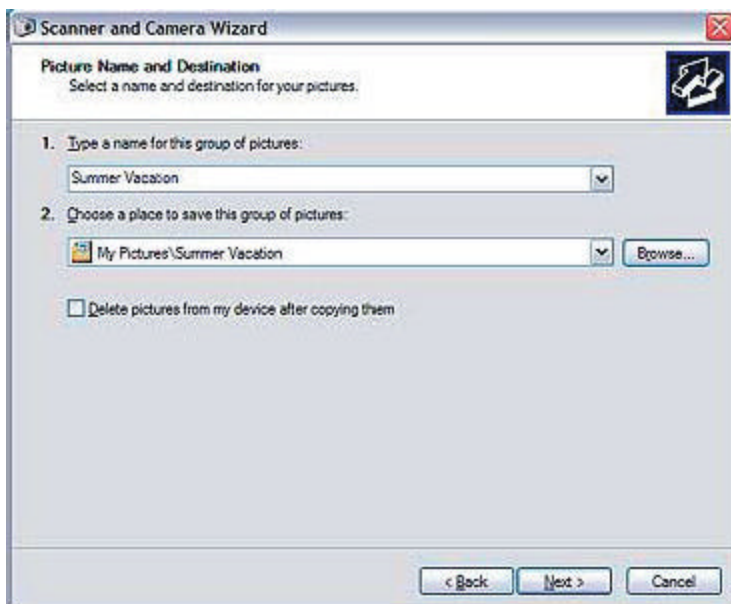
Click **Copy pictures to a folder**, and then click **OK**.



If you want to transfer all the photos in your camera (or on your memory card), click **Next**. But if you only want to transfer some of the pictures, click **Clear All**, and then click on the boxes next to the photos you want to transfer, and then click **Next**.



The wizard puts your photos in the My Pictures folder on your computer unless you choose another location. Click **Next**.



When the transfer is complete, select what you want to do next or click **Finish**. The folder that contains your newly imported photos opens and your transferring is complete.
